The Ring & Ride Trustees are very pleased to be launching the expansion of MNR (Midsomer Norton & Radstock) Ring & Ride from 25th Sept '06. The expansion is being facilitated by funding provided by Bath & North East Somerset Council, Norton Radstock Town Council, & Peasedown St. John Parish Council. Two brand new, low-floor, easily accessible buses have been purchased, which will provide a very high quality service.

What is Midsomer Norton & Radstock Ring & Ride?

A door-to-door, fully accessible bus service specialising in providing excellent customer care services for older and disabled people and others who cannot access conventional public transport services.

Midsomer Norton & Radstock Ring & Ride Town Service

Who can use the Town Service?

Registered members who are elderly or have a mobility or communication problem.

You can use the service to travel to a number of destinations for whatever you need to do, such as doctor appointments, shopping, social trips to visit relatives and friends, lunch clubs and libraries.

Can I bring a friend?

Yes, you can bring a companion with you if you feel their support is needed.

When does the service operate?

9.00 am to 4.00 pm Mon-Fri

How much will it cost?

For those who have paid their Registration fee of £3 a single fare of £2, return £3.

Diamond Card holders are entitled to a 50% reduction.

Ring & Ride Hopper Service

Can I bring a helper?

Yes if their support is necessary.
(The helper will have to pay the normal fare).
